What did we do?

We went to visit children with various disabilities. While staying at the center, our team members help them to carry boxes and clean up together. There is one thing that leave us great impression was that when we tried to communicate with them, it is more difficult than we thought, and most times they don't really understand what others are

talking about. This experience led us to further contemplation.





What we did?

- After we cleaned up together, we started to play games with them. Both our group members and children are separated into serveral teams and each team contains three people
- During gaming, we laughed a lot and had a wonderful afternoon.



Environment

- The center we went is nice, they have rooms for children to play sports with many facilities in it; rooms for children to spend time drawing whatever they want to draw; rooms for them to store things which makes the place looks neat and rooms for disabled children to do recovery exercises.
- Children live properly at the center, they have beds like we usually sleep at school.

Conclusion for Trip 1

- We found that people are willing to contribute some of their things to these social vulnerable communities, but only a few people will spend time to accompany these children.
- Normally, people have to work at day time, struggling with demanding tasks, coping relationship s with their bosses and colleagues. They have dedicated most of their time in their career. Therefore, they, accordingly, have less time to care about others. These children's parents are classic examples. They have their works, so they might not able to have enough time to accompany with their children.
- The center's workers told us that there are indeed some people spend time asking about these children, but very few of them take actions.
- But fortunately, the center have great facilities and nice workers.

Trip 2

- This time, we visited leftover children.
- Their parents left them because of different reasons(e.g. find jobs).



What did we do?

- During the trip, we spent most of the time talking with those children and had classes together.
- We are also allowed to visit their home.



Environment

- They don't have convenient transportation. Therefore, if they want to order a dilivery, they have to walk for an hour to reach the express station.
- They have some basic entertaining facilities, places for playing basketball, table tennis, badminton and some exercise facilities.
- Their teachers have their individual office; Students have fans but not air conditioners in their classrooms. The school only owns a handful of teachers, approximately three teachers each grade. Therefore, with such scarce educational resource, one teacher has to teach multiple subjects.
- THe air quality there is quite pure since they don't have tall buildings and lots of vehicles like big cities.
- Every family owns a specific area of land for agriculture.

Children's daily lives

- Children have their own phones. They also play mobile games and watch videos like we do.
- They like to play basketball during breaks, rushing out the classroom and play basketball with friends like us.
- They use wechat pay to buy snacks at the store.
- A pity is that children lack high quality of education since the poor transportation has blocked many high educated.
